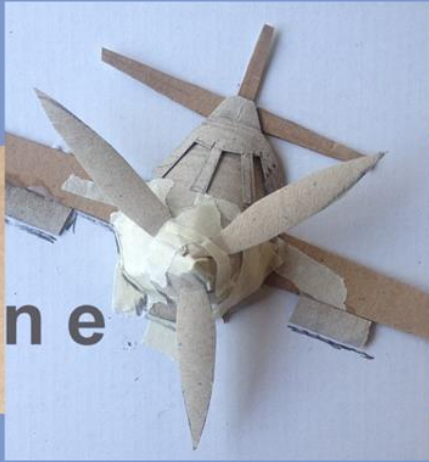




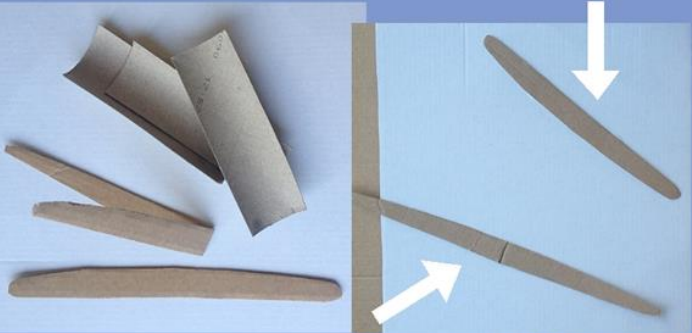
Toilet Roll Fighter Plane



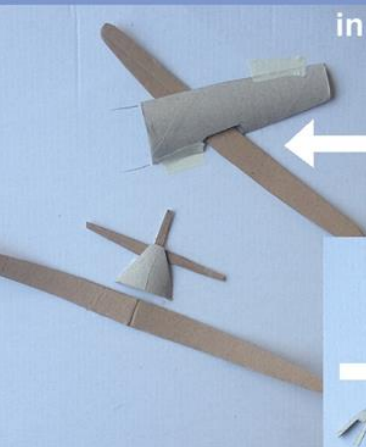

1 - Cut some cardboard tubes in half and cut some thin lengths of card like this . . .

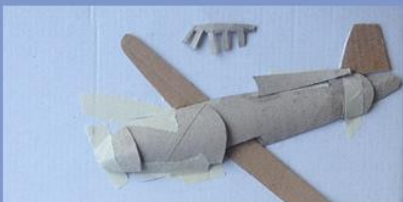
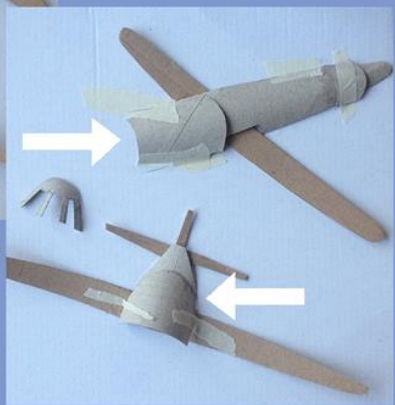


. . you can fold the card in half so that it's equal.

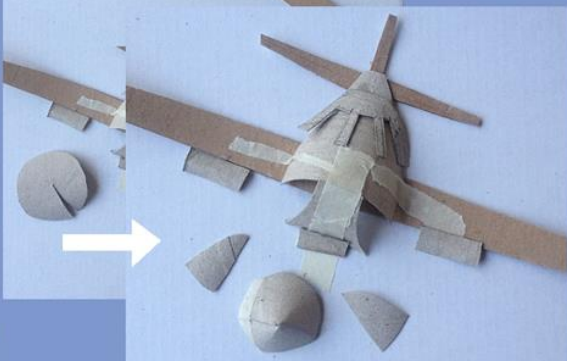


2 - Use pieces of the tube to create the basic shape of the aircraft.

3 - You can cut these with a 'curved' edge to make them seem more 3D.



4 - Add more details, the tail, cockpit, and make 'cones' . . .



. . for the front of the aircraft.



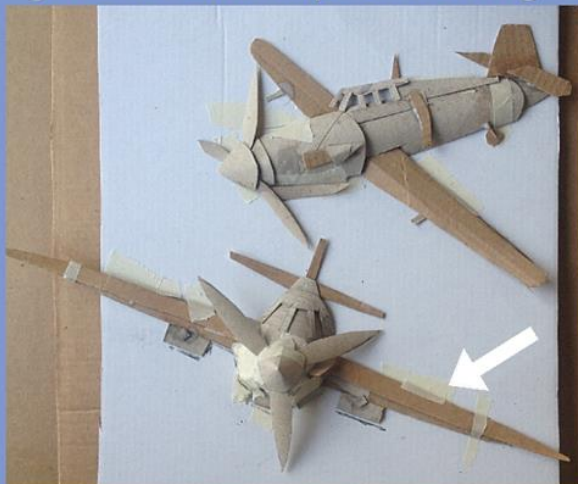
5 - Cut out some propeller shapes, you can use one as a template?



6 - Keep on adding small details, I've also made another cone to go over the propellers.



7 - Final details, I've made a wheel, guns and extra strips on the wings.



. . . now you can paint it.
